Loaded with old school notes of cassis, charcuterie, gamey meats, dark fruit and wild herbs, it's medium to full-bodied, has a full, layered mid-palate and a beautiful, elegant, seamless texture. It should drink reasonably well on release, but will be better with short term cellaring and drink well through 2028. Drink date 2016-2028.
